

## **INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE DURING THE WORLD BIOMETRICS DAY EVENT**

In accordance with Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: **GDPR**), we inform you how we will process your personal data.

### **I Administrator of Personal Data**

The administrator of personal data is the Global Biometrics Council Association with its registered office in Wrocław, ul. Eugeniusza Kwiatkowskiego 4, 52-407 Wrocław, entered into the register of associations of the National Court Register by the District Court for Wrocław, Fabryczna, in Wrocław, VI Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000932967, NIP: 894-317-70-12, REGON: 520536028, (hereinafter referred to as: "Association"), website: <https://globalbiometricscouncil.com/>.

### **II Purposes and grounds for processing**

We process personal data in order to:

- a. register participation in the conference during World Biometrics Day, communicate with participants in organizational matters and document the proceedings of the conference course. The legal basis for data processing is your consent (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR).
- b. publication and transmission of the image on websites administered by the Association (including social networks Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn and on the YouTube channel), sent in the application and recorded during participation in the World Biometrics Day conference on the 07.10.2022. The legal basis for data processing is your consent (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR).
- c. marketing of own products and services – the legal basis is the implementation of a legally justified interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, where the legitimate interest is direct marketing), with the proviso that the transmission of commercial information by means of electronic communication, the use of telecommunications terminal equipment and automatic calling devices for marketing purposes, is only possible with your consent.

### **III Recipients of data**

Your personal data may be transferred or made available to:

- a. members or associates of the Association supporting its activities, including providing IT services, providing telecommunications, marketing, auditing, or legal services, who, on the basis of a contract for entrusting the processing of personal data or authorization to process personal data, process this data on behalf of the Association;
- b. public authorities and entities performing public tasks or acting on behalf of public authorities, to the extent and for purposes that result from the provisions of generally applicable law;
- c. other entities which, on the basis of binding agreements on entrusting data processing signed with the Association, or process personal data on behalf of the Association.

### **IV Transfer of data to third countries or international organisations**

The Association does not transfer data outside the EU or the European Economic Area on its own. However, the specificity of the operation and the transnational nature of data flow mean that it is potentially possible to transfer data outside EOG (it is not dependent on us) within the following services:

## **V Data retention period**

Your personal data will be stored until you withdraw your consent or until the purpose of data processing is fully achieved (if possible).

## **VI Your rights:**

You are entitled to:

- a. The right to access your data and receive a copy thereof;
- b. The right to rectify (correct) your data;
- c. Right to erasure;
- d. Right to restriction of data processing;
- e. The right to object to the processing of data;
- f. Right to data collection;
- g. The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection: ul. Stawki 2; 00-193 Warszawa; <https://www.uodo.gov.pl/pl/p/kontakt>; tel. (22) 531 03 00 - when you consider that the face of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR or other provisions regarding the processing of personal data;

- h. The right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data.

You have the right to withdraw, at any time, your consent to the processing of such personal data, processed on the basis of consent. Withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

## **VII Information about the freedom or obligation to provide data**

Providing data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes as well as is a condition for contacting you for marketing purposes.

## **VIII Other information**

The Association will not make decisions towards you in an automated manner, including as a result of profiling, having legal effects on you, or similarly significantly affecting you.
